Brief Report on Kisan Diwas 2025 Celebrations at SAIRD-KVK, Gaddipally

SAIRD–Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVK), Gaddipally, organized the Kisan Diwas (National Farmers' Day) celebrations on its campus on the occasion of Kisan Diwas 2025. As part of the programme, a Kisan Mela and Agricultural Exhibition were conducted at the KVK premises. The event witnessed the participation of around 600 farmers and 60 students, along with officials from ICAR, private industry representatives, and members of the press and media.

The programme was graced by Shri Tejas Nandlal Pawar, IAS, District Collector and Magistrate, Suryapet, as the Chief Guest. The Honorary Guests included Dr. Shaik N. The Collector appreciated the dedicated efforts of KVK, Gaddipally, in serving the farming community and emphasized demand-based production, value addition, environmentally friendly practices, mechanization and the formation of Farmer Producer
